Circular note to Chief Executive Officers and Managing Directors of Power utilities

Dear Madam / Dear Sir,

Subject: Capacity Building - 2023 Training Program

The African Network of Centers of Excellence in Electricity (ANCEE) is a continental initiative led by the Association of Power Utilities of Africa African (APUA) and financially supported by the African Development Fund (ADF) of the African Development Bank Group (AfDB) and the French Development Agency (AFD).

The overall objective of ANCEE is to improve the performance of Power sector and to intensify regional exchanges through the strengthening of technical and managerial capacities in the various trades, as well as the governance of the sector.

ANCEE will enter its seventh year of implementation with more than 7,200 people already trained and training actions underway. The services of ANCEE are not limited to so-called classic training relating to the electricity trades, but also offers suitable training modules that meet specific specifications or terms of reference drawn up by your HR and training structures. All these actions will allow us to support you for better targeting of needs and better prioritization in the programming of training.

I would like to urge you to send us diligently all your priority training needs, in the entire chain of electricity trades so that the ANCEE Coordination Unit can process them and send you offers adapted to your needs.

As such, it should be remembered that a subsidy mechanism allows ANCEE to bear part of the cost of training (**50% for fragile countries***) with an additional bonus granted for training in renewable energies (+15%). and training for the benefit of women (+10%).



The success of this initiative is based on the growing interest shown by the electricity companies in the effective realization of their budgeted training plans.
