#### Background

- Mozambique's Development Plan highlights industrial development, infrastructure and tourism.
  To improve productivity and become more competitive, industry needs stable and reliable electricity supply.
- Power can play a meaningful part in Mozambique's development by putting in place the necessary capacity, detailing the correct energy mix, instituting investment policies that are business and tax friendly, and ensuring the collection and proper use of revenue by the power distributors to ensure a minimal and predictable burden on all consumers.
- Availability of financial resources for Investments in the energy sector in Mozambique is the key driver to increase electricity access towards *Universal Access by 2030*. These will complement the Government of Mozambique efforts envisaging poverty reduction, improvement of agriculture activities and stimulate industrialization of country.






- The achievement of universal access to electricity in Mozambique.


#### **EDM Strategy**

- Develop a Leadership Program to build strength to drive the company in order to achieve the strategic objectives.






#### **Generation Projects**


Whit this action we are committed that the key factor for all those initiatives of energy transition only can be achieved by human capital development and gender equity

## 2023 **3900** EMPLOYEES




## 2030 **4900** EMPLOYEES





#### HUMAN CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT EMPLOYEE LIFE CYCLE (ELC)



- ✓ ELC is composed by 40 activities and it guides from retention to retirement on how to manage the life of the employee.
- ✓ To achieve universal access, EDM have been contracting more than 200 employees/year.
- ✓ + 1500 employees have to be trained per year with focus on:
- a) Specialised training in operations
  (Distribution, Generation and Transmission).
- b) Technical training for women to move from basic level to expert level.
- c) Techinical support to implemente 11 laboratory facilities and train the trainers.





### **Closing Remarks**

- EDM is committed to energy transition through ongoing efforts to achieve Universal Access to energy by 2030 and net zero by 2050 Ensure Universal Access to Energy by 2030.
- **Mozambique needs energy**, and it needs it fast. Energy is an enabler of development.
- With its **abundant RE (renewable energy)** resource, Mozambique can play a huge role in the regional power generation.
- Integrated Master Plan for Power Sector will require a large amount of capital investment in infrastructure to enable RE intermittency projects and energy efficiency.
- There is a **clear opportunity for investors** to play a key role in technical assistance and the development of power projects in Mozambique, through **Public-Private Partnership and project finance methodologies**.
- "Gender equity is part of EDM key strategy" EDM recognizes the importance of addressing gender disparities and aims to create a more inclusive and balanced environment within the industry.
- Local content is adding value to the host country.
